CURRICULUM NEWSLETTER

This half term our curriculum theme is **Mountains, Volcanoes and Earthquakes.**



Our enquiry question is:

What are the similarities of mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes?



ENGLISH - WRITING

In writing lessons the children will be learning how to write a Greek Myth, following on from our learning of last half term.

We will be reading a selection of Greek Myths with the outcome of writing a new version ourselves.

ENGLISH - READING

During this half term, the children will be continuing to focus on applying their phonic understanding in Read Write Inc. In class, we will be reading the Wild Robot.



MATHEMATICS

Working within their year group level, the children will be working upon units of length, perimeter and area and then will be applying their numerical knowledge to start looking at fractions.







GEOGRAPHY

This half term we will be learning about mountains, volcanoes and earthquakes and looking at the similarities. The children will learn how mountains and volcanoes are formed, how earthquakes occur and what happens in an eruption.

SCIENCE

We will be learning about plants and what they need to grow. This will include an observation over time of plants growing in different environments.

ART

This half term the children will be finishing off their oil portraits and then looking at printing on different materials.



RELGIOUS EDUCATION

We will be looking at how religious groups contribute to society.



COMPUTING

The children will be using micro:bits to learn about coding.

FRENCH

The children will be learning how the names of animals and use these to form sentences.

PSHE



The children will be thinking about their place in society and what they can do to be a good citizen.

The children will be continue to appraise different genres of music and they will develop their skills in performance and composition.
